

How to write a good written expression

To make sure that you get a maximum of points in your written expression you have to follow these rules :

- Start with an indent (indent means that you leave space at the beginning of your paragraph) .
- Respect the number of lines you've been told to write (and this is very important, never break this rule as this can cost you to lose points) .
- Avoid repetition (no one would like to read a written expression where the same word is written over and over again ! so make sure that you use a variety of words and don't be afraid to show the reader your capacity in writing) .
- Use the transition words (transition words are very very important and can get you some extra points so make sure that you add them whenever you have a chance some examples of transition words that you can use : (in addition to; furthermore; moreover; another) and these are used to add information , (thus; therefore; consequently) are used to express a result) .
- Use capital letters at the beginning of every sentence.
- Use a period “.” At the end of every paragraph .

- Don't ignore punctuation (! , . : () ?).
- Take some time to reread your paragraph and correct any mistakes you find in your way.
